

MINUTES OF MEETING
COMMON COUNCIL
CITY OF MONTICELLO
SEPTEMBER 18, 2006

The regular meeting of the City of Monticello, Indiana Common Council was held on September 18, 2006 in the Council Chambers of the City Building at 6:00PM. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Fox and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call by Clerk Treasurer Rennatta Berkshire was answered by Mayor Robert Fox, Councilpersons Bud Mummert, Jim Mann and Jay Clawson. City Attorney George Loy, Councilpersons William Smith, Grace Oilar, absent.

There being no additions, deletions or corrections to the minutes of the regular meeting of September 05, 2006, a motion was made by Councilperson Mann seconded by Councilperson Clawson to approve the minutes as presented. Roll call vote: all aye.

Citizen Participation

Larry Droski who lives on Gordon Road said that traffic on Gordon Road exceeded the 35mph speed limit. Chief Reynolds said that he would have the officers patrol that area more often, however, the department is operating as best it can to respond to complaints. Mr. Droski also asked if there is an ordinance stating how many persons can occupy a house. Councilperson Clawson said that White County Area Plan is working on an ordinance that will address that issue by regulating the number of persons per square feet rather than trying to regulate the number by a family definition.

Charles Mellon said that when he had an accident the report came back that he did not have insurance but he did and wondered why the officer had not put that on the accident report. Chief Reynolds said that there is a time lapse between when the insurance company sends the information to the state and not an error on the officer's report.

Department Head Reports

Chief Logan reported that the White County Commissioners had accepted the new three (3) year ambulance contract at their morning meeting. Superintendent Roberts reported that the sidewalk project for 2006 has been completed. He also reported that the blacktopping projects are completed with the exception of one (1) parking lot.

Second Reading Ordinance 2006-15, Budget Ordinance for 2007

Clerk Treasurer Berkshire read Ordinance 2006-15 for the second time by title only. A motion was made by Councilperson Clawson seconded by Councilperson Mummert to adopt Ordinance 2006-15, Budget Ordinance for 2007. Roll call vote: all aye.

Accounts Payable

A motion was made by Councilperson Mann seconded by Councilperson Clawson to approve the Accounts Payables as presented by Clerk Treasurer Berkshire. Roll call vote: all aye.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:15PM.
