

**MINUTES OF MEETING  
COMMON COUNCIL  
CITY OF MONTICELLO  
JANUARY 03, 2006**

The regular meeting of the City of Monticello, Indiana Common Council was held on January 03, 2006 in the Council Chambers of the City Building at 6:00PM. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert Fox and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call by Clerk Treasurer Rennatta Berkshire was answered by Mayor Robert Fox, City Attorney George Loy, Councilpersons William Smith, Grace Oilar, Bud Mummert, Jim Mann, Jay Clawson.

There being no additions, deletions or corrections to the minutes of the regular meeting of December 19, 2005, a motion was made by Councilperson Oilar seconded by Councilperson Clawson to accept the minutes as presented. Roll call vote: all aye.

**Citizen Participation**

Mr. Kenneth Kersey informed the Council that he has resigned as a member of the Emergency Management Association team and extended his gratitude and appreciation for the cooperation between the Council and the EMA. He said he will continue to monitor the handicap parking spaces as a civilian and will continue to write tickets to those who park in the spaces without a permit. Mr. Kersey said that most of the vertical handicap signs are in place; however, there are still a few businesses that have not complied.

**Funding City Website**

Mr. Dave Brechbiel of *One Technologies* was present to answer questions. Councilperson Smith said that the committee has met with Mr. Brechbiel and the website plans have been compiled. The cost of the service will be \$11,950.00. Mayor Fox said he has been in contact with the Economic Development Commission and \$8,000.00 will be funded by the EDC. Each department will have access to updating information to keep the site current. Mr. Brechbiel said that there will be a main page with links to the various offices and departments within the City as well as other links that may be added. Clerk Treasurer Berkshire said that another component of the site will be the ability to link to American Legal which will be the host site for the City ordinances and resolutions. The public will have the ability to type in key words to find the ordinance or resolution relating to a specific subject. Additional cost to the initial setup for American Legal will be approximately \$1,250 with the current annual charge for updating the code. The service that Mr. Brechbiel will provide is to design the site, develop the reference page area, add database/links, create department and office pages with training, set up the events calendar with administration backend and training, a "contact us form", e-mail, and subcontracted services for photo and technical writing. After the first year the maintenance contract will be offered, however, he does not think there will be a great need for this after everyone is trained and able to update their information. Cost for the maintenance contract runs approximately 20% of the total cost. A motion was made by Councilperson Oilar seconded by Councilperson Smith to approve the funding for the City website as proposed by *One Technologies, Inc* to be disbursed from the Rainy Day Fund.

**Miscellaneous and All Other Matter**

Councilperson Clawson reminded the other members that the Fire Department needs direction for building repairs and asked that this be placed on the agenda for the next meeting. Mayor Fox reminded everyone that there would be a ceremony to swear in four new firemen following this meeting.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:20PM.
